will be minimized as well as the reducing the time needed for the location of paged items.

The installation of SelfCheck Stations, BiblioGates, BiblioReturn Machines and an efficient, quiet Sorting System has started in autumn 2008. The Springdale Library has a wide collection of 195,000 items with a circulation of 700,000 annually. It typically adds 18,000 items to its collection each year.
