Reputable US academy in West Point modernizes its entire library holdings

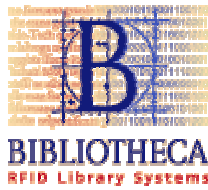

system and enables fast and efficient media management.”

Special RFID labels for AV media performing self-service and security functions are among the other benefits USMA appreciates. Consequently, additional lockable plastic boxes are no longer required. The software registers the entire content of the media packages without these having to be opened and processed individually. The portable, wireless BiblioWand operates in real-time mode and enables efficient and precise inventory control, as well as selective search for misplaced media directly at the shelf.
